Treatments include prescribing therapies and exercises, coordinating treatment plans with therapists and nurses, prescribing medications and performing injections.

Services We Offer to Skilled Nursing Facilities

- Oversight of functional patient care.
- Patient visits 2-3 x/week as needed.
- Attendance at weekly insurance meeting to discuss safe discharge plans.
- Attendance during family meeting/care plans as needed.
- Coordinate treatment with Primary doctor, specialists, therapy, and nursing and communicate with patient and family on progress.
- Sign home health and equipment orders for discharge.
- Olinical documentation to help support therapy, audits and surveys.
- Peer to peer reviews for insurance denials.
- Diagnose orthopedic and neurologic and musculoskeletal conditions.
- Perform Botox, nerve blocks, mange baclofen pumps for spasticity post stroke/TBI/spinal cord injury.
- Manage pain/opioids medications.
- Management of wounds.
- Management of Delirium.
- Management of Neurogenic Bladder and Bowel.
- Provide in-service education for nursing/therapy team as needed for precautions and establish protocols for prevention of bed sores, falls and UTI.
